Why Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet?

St. Faustina had a love for the sick and dying and she prayed for them with great fervor.....Jesus told her, "At the hour of death, I defend as my own glory every soul that will say this chaplet, or when others say it for a dying person, the indulgence is the same."

This is the procedure for making prayer requests:

- 1) Call (337) 365-5095 with the name and address of the person in need of prayer.
- 2) The information will be passed on to our prayer disciples.
- 3) Someone will call to make an appointment with you and/or your loved one.
- 4) We can either pray for you remotely or IN PERSON (recommended).
- 5) If IN PERSON prayer is requested, a team of 2 volunteers will come to your home, hospital or nursing home and pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet and/or the Rosary for your intentions. After the first visit, we will schedule future visits on a weekly or monthly basis.

This is not a social call. We realize that someone who is sick doesn't feel like a lot of activity. We usually stay 30 minutes if the Rosary is prayed as well. **It is our way of bringing GOD and church to you.**

We have a dedicated team of volunteers. Please use us as an instrument in coming closer to God and neighbor.
