Invite a single friend over for a meal; Turn off the TV, phone, and computer, and spend an hour devoted to someone you love; Attend an extra Mass on a weekday this month; Abstain from something you like—meat, a latte, a cold drink—on Fridays and save the money for a charity; Take your rosary with you for an early morning walk; Recycle more; Think of a charity which is amply blessed at Christmas. Remember it with a gift mid-year; Each day, say a prayer for one of the world's trouble spots; Surprise an old friend with a phone call; Buy or pick a flower for someone without a "reason"; Take your family to a farmer's market if in season; Stop for a moment during your busy day and enjoy an ice cream cone or other favorite treat; If you hear a great homily, tell the homilist; Splurge on some produce and buy enough to share with someone in need; On occasion, try turning your prayer before meals into a spontaneous prayer of thanks, using your own words.

PRAYER FOR HURRICANE SEASON-June 1-November 30-O God, Master of this passing world, hear the humble voices of your children. The Sea of Galilee obeyed your order and returned to its former quietude; You are still the Master of land and sea.
