



Whereas the meaning of disciple is "learner," here the emphasis is on their being sent out. If fishermen (two sets of brothers, with the family dynamics that might involve), a tax collector, a hot-headed revolutionary Zealot, a traitor, and the rest, could be chosen by Jesus as the first sent ones, then surely there is hope for the church today.
